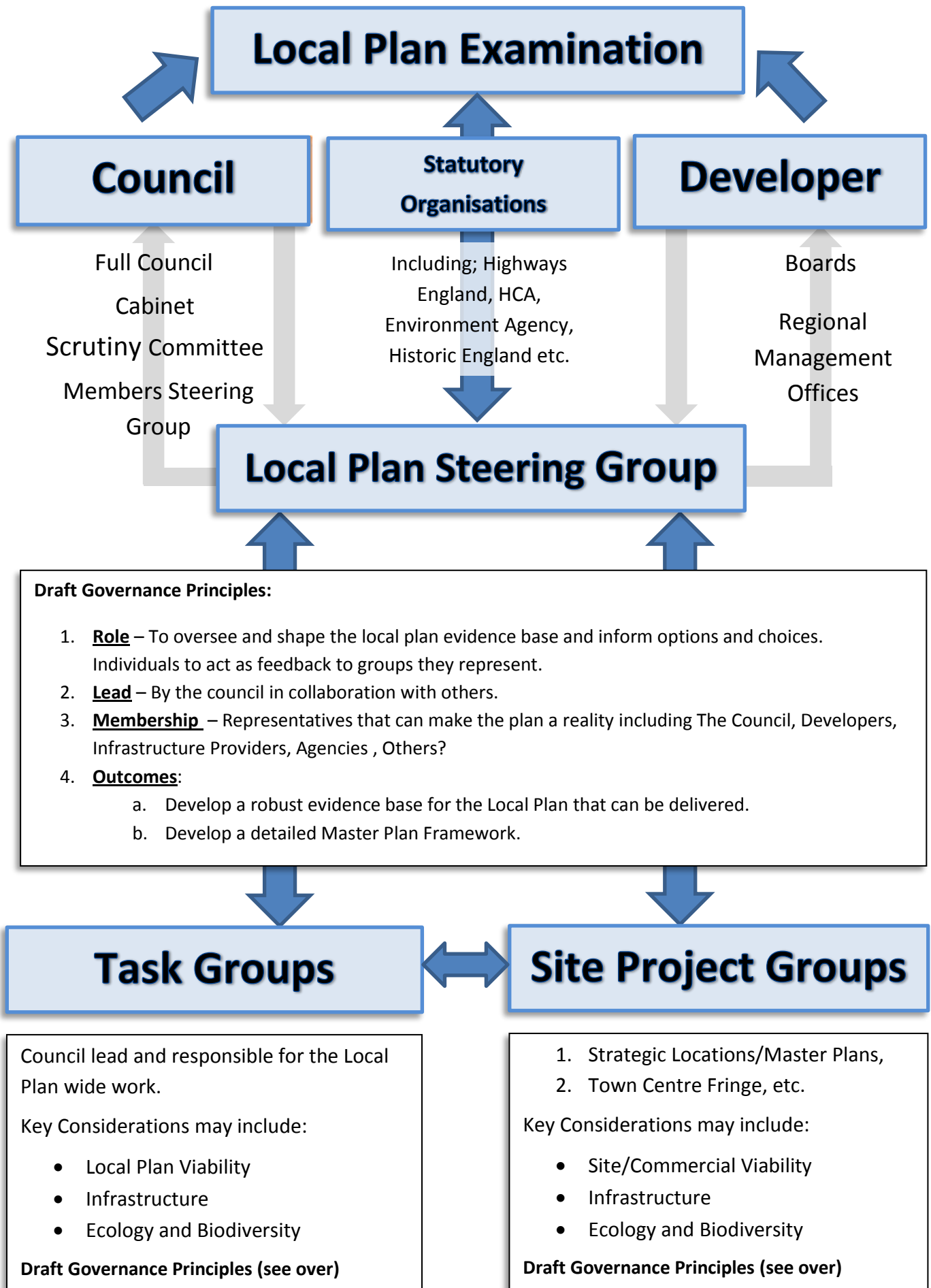
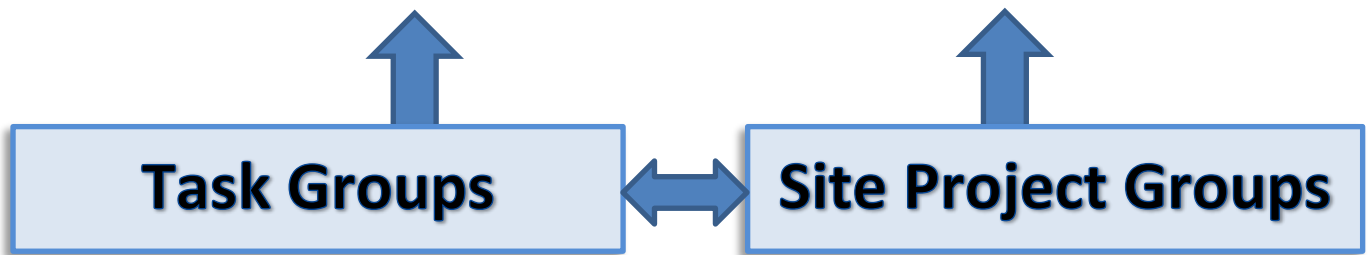


## Draft Local Plan Governance Structure





#### Draft Governance Principles

1. **Role** – To research, investigate and develop responses to Local Plan wide issues.
2. **Lead** – Lead to be assigned appropriate to task/issue.
3. **Membership** – Representatives of key stakeholders relevant to topic, technical experts, community or interest groups.
4. **Outcomes:**
  - a. To develop a robust plan wide evidence base and responses to delivery in the wider plan context.
  - b. To inform policy development.
  - c. To inform the delivery of the plan making agenda at a site project level.

#### Draft Governance Principles

1. **Role** – To develop the evidence base to demonstrate the appropriate allocation of development sites and on the inclusion of policy that will guide future developments.
2. **Lead** – Developers/Landowners
3. **Membership** – Developers, Landowners, infrastructure providers, 'gate keepers' including local communities.
4. **Outcomes:**
  - a. Evidence base to answer ATLAS '7 Questions'.
  - b. Successful allocation of sites within the local plan.
  - c. Informing the place making agenda at Local Plan scale.
  - d. Concept plans for strategic development.
